

#### Safety Message from the School Crossing Patrol Service

Would parents please refrain from enabling pupils to disembark from vehicles at the zebra crossing. This practise is both illegal and dangerous. Other drivers may accelerate to overtake the vehicle which compromises the safety of their own child, the crossing patrol and other Leigh Beck pupils. Drivers should never drop children off within the Zig Zag lines of the zebra crossing.

A concern for pupils exiting vehicles in a rush is that they can stumble from cars as they exit vehicles, children and car doors can collide with cyclists who do not expect car doors to suddenly open, children could drop items and need to retrieve them from under cars, close to the vehicle's wheels. I have witnessed pupils becoming very upset when they have left something inside the vehicle which has driven off and they have then attempted to run after the vehicle to retrieve it putting themselves in danger. Please Park up in the Football Gound Car Park sensibly and allow children to exit cars safely.

On all patrolled crossings across Essex, children are expected to dismount from bikes and scooters and walk them over the pedestrian crossing. I would like to say thank you to all the pupils that are dismounting. Please continue to encourage your child/children to dismount as it is good practise for when the children get older and make unaccompanied journeys, as by dismounting at roads, this will allow them to give their full attention to approaching traffic.
